

MG Financing Substitution Form (2009-10)

PROJECT FINANCING WITH NO TRF MATCH

Explanation: The Matching Grant budget for the 2009-10 Rotary year was significantly reduced from prior years as a result of the unrealized losses due to the global recession. Due to the limited budget, project sponsors have the option of submitting applications substituting DDF in place of the originally requested award from The Rotary Foundation (TRF) or with no TRF award. This option can be chosen throughout the Rotary year to ensure that your application is not impacted by the full commitment of the MG budget or can be submitted as revised financing after the budget has been expended. Before your grant can be approved you will need to fully complete the form below demonstrating the sources of financing for the project.

Instructions: Clearly list all financing in U.S. dollars noting which funds will be contributed in cash and which will be contributed from District Designated Funds (DDF). Use of DDF must be authorized by the district Rotary Foundation committee chair and the district governor. The project financing must equal the proposed budget without any funding request from TRF.

NOTE: No funds should be sent to TRF prior to official Trustee approval. Upon approval, a letter will be sent to the sponsors notifying them of approval and providing detailed instructions on how and where to submit their contributions.
